

# What is APPLE.COM/BILL on My Bank Statement?

**APPLE.COM/BILL** is a billing descriptor used by Apple for charges related to the App Store, iTunes, iCloud, Apple Music, or subscriptions like Apple TV+ or Apple Arcade.

## Why Am I Being Charged by APPLE.COM/BILL?

This charge usually appears after you or a family member has:

- Purchased an app, movie, song, or subscription
- Upgraded iCloud storage
- Subscribed to an Apple service (e.g., Apple Music, Fitness+)

Family Sharing plans often cause confusion if someone else in your household made the purchase.

## How to See What You Were Charged For

To identify the charge, go to:

- [reportaproblem.apple.com](https://reportaproblem.apple.com)
- Sign in with your Apple ID
- Review your recent purchases and subscriptions

## Is APPLE.COM/BILL a Legit Charge?

Yes—it's a real charge, but if you don't recognize it, it could be from someone else on your Family Sharing plan or an old subscription that auto-renewed. You can cancel recurring charges through your Apple ID account settings.

## How to Cancel Apple Subscriptions

To cancel an Apple service or subscription:

- On iPhone: Go to **Settings > [your name] > Subscriptions**
- Find the subscription and tap **Cancel**
- Or visit [Apple's support site](https://support.apple.com) to manage online
