

What is TURBOTAX on My Bank Statement?

TURBOTAX or **INTUIT*TURBOTAX** is a billing label used when you pay for tax filing services through TurboTax, which is owned by Intuit. Charges can come from one-time use or from optional add-ons you may have selected during the filing process.

Why Am I Being Charged by TurboTax?

Common reasons include:

- Filing federal or state taxes using TurboTax Deluxe, Premier, or Self-Employed
- Choosing “Pay With My Refund” (an extra service fee)
- Upgrading to live support or audit protection
- Filing through the app and selecting paid services

What is TurboTax?

TurboTax is an online tax preparation service that helps individuals and businesses file taxes with step-by-step guidance. It offers both free and paid options depending on complexity and support levels.

Is the TurboTax Charge Legit?

Usually yes—but it’s easy to lose track of extra services selected during tax filing. Check your Intuit account at myturbotax.intuit.com to confirm your charges.

How to Cancel or Get a Refund

If the charge is incorrect:

- Visit the [TurboTax refund request page](#)
- Complete the form for billing support
