

# What is UBER on My Bank Statement?

**UBER** or **UBER TRIP** is a billing label for ride-sharing, Uber Eats, or subscription fees like Uber One. Charges may vary by location and service type.

## Why Am I Being Charged by Uber?

You may have:

- Taken a ride or scheduled one
- Ordered food via Uber Eats
- Paid a cancellation or no-show fee
- Been charged for a monthly Uber One subscription

## What is Uber?

Uber is a platform for ride-sharing, food delivery, and local transport services. It's used globally, and charges may reflect rides, deliveries, fees, or subscriptions.

## Is the Uber Charge Legit?

Most likely yes, but it's worth reviewing. Log into the Uber or Uber Eats app, go to **Activity**, and select **Past Rides** or **Orders** to confirm.

## How to Cancel Uber One or Dispute a Charge

To cancel Uber One:

- Go to **Account > Uber One**
- Tap **Manage Membership**, then **End Membership**

For disputes, select the charge in your ride history and follow the in-app help flow.

### What is UBER on my credit card?

It's likely a ride, food delivery, or subscription fee from Uber or Uber Eats.

### Why did Uber charge me when I didn't ride?

It could be a cancellation or no-show fee. Check your ride history to verify.

### How do I stop Uber charges?

Cancel Uber One and make sure no rides or deliveries are pending on your account.
